

## Boat charter fees and conditions (May 2007)

### General Boats charter conditions in Morocco

- 1) Rates are negotiable dependent upon payment terms, duration and quantities of equipment
- 2) Order form must be provided at least 20 days before mobilization day
- 3) Advance payment of 50% at least 15 days before mobilization day
- 4) Balance of payment must be done on demobilization day
- 5) All extra costs (diesel, gasoline, port charges, permit fees, local taxes, etc.) payable by customer
- 6) Maximum ten-hour working day (in accordance with condition No.7)
- 7) All boats must be moored in a port between sunset and sunrise (absolutely no work at night due to local regulations)
- 8) If boat is not moored after sunset, then 150% of "at sea" rate applies
- 9) Under 5 hours work at sea proportional "per hour" rate applies (rounded to ½ hour) added to "standby rates"
- 10) After 5 hours of work at sea full day rate applies

### Moroccan charter conditions

- 2) General boats charter conditions in Morocco applies
- 3) **Two crew members included**
- 4) **All normal scuba diving support included in fares (scuba tanks, tank filling, weights, weight belts, etc...)**
- 5) Engines maintenance must be done every 150 hours, working schedule must take it into account
- 6) Twelve (12) passengers maximum
- 7) Two (2) metric tons maximum weight carriage

### Other countries charter conditions

- 1) All Morocco hiring conditions apply
- 2) Written authorization must be provided by customer before mobilization day
- 3) Working hours must comply with local regulations
- 4) If Aqua Star is not safely moored alongside a quay, then extra costs apply
- 5) Extra insurance at customer's expense (except for Spain which is included in fares)
